### Policy on CFVA eBulletin Re-Prints

Articles published in the CFVA eBulletin are copyrighted works of the CFVA, made for hire by the contract writers employed by CFVA to write for the eBulletin.

As requested, on a case-by-case basis, the Communications Committee of the CFVA, as directed by the Executive Committee of the CFVA, may approve the reuse of articles that have appeared in the CFVA eBulletin. This reprint policy has been established to protect CFVA's brand and copyright interests in works owned by CFVA that have been published in CFVA's eBulletin email newsletter.

When such use is approved, Comm/Comm will extract the article from the eBulletin, format it in a *standard* CFVA article format, and place it in a free-standing PDF file (hosted on the CFVA.COM website) where it may be linked-to directly by outside sites and organizations. (Use of a PDF file discourages the article text from being harvested or altered.)

The relevant outside organization may publish the first few lines of the text, the first paragraph of the text, or a CFVA-approved excerpt of the article, under the original article headline, followed by a "click to read more..." link that refers to the PDF file containing the entire article.

Except as allowed in this policy, CFVA does not allow reuse of *text of copyrighted articles* appearing in the CFVA eBulletin.
